RI Areas of Focus for Global Grants:

"Disease Prevention and Treatment"

"Maternal and Child Health Care"

- 29 monitors @ estimated R200 000 each
- = R5.8 million or US\$ 424 000
- A global grant may not exceed \$200 000

Possible solutions:

- Split into two or more grants by several Districts
- Bring the Government into the partnership
- Use our international contacts to procure the equipment at lower prices
