

YEARS OF DOING GOOD IN THE WORLD

- At the 1917 convention in Atlanta, outgoing Rotary President Arch Klumph proposed to set up an endowment “for the purpose of doing good in the world.”
- In 1928, it was renamed The Rotary Foundation, and it became a distinct entity within Rotary International.

- In 1929, the Foundation made its first gift of \$500 to the International Society for Crippled Children.
- When Rotary founder Paul Harris died in 1947, the Paul Harris Memorial Fund was created to build the Foundation.

YEARS OF DOING GOOD IN THE WORLD

- 1947: The Foundation established its first program, later known as Ambassadorial Scholarships.
- 1965-66: Three programs launched: Group Study Exchange, Awards for Technical Training, and Grants for Activities in Keeping with the Objective of The Rotary Foundation, later called Matching Grants.
- 1978: The first 3-H (Health, Hunger and Humanity) Grant was to immunize 6 million Philippine children against polio.

YEARS OF DOING GOOD IN THE WORLD

- 1985: The PolioPlus programme was launched to eradicate polio worldwide.
- 1987-88: The first peace forums were held, leading to Rotary Peace Fellowships.
- 2013: New district and global grants introduced.



The Rotary Foundation



- 24 October 2016: World Polio Day (established by Rotary International over a decade ago to commemorate the birth of Jonas Salk, who led the first team to develop a vaccine against poliomyelitis.
- Since the first donation of \$26.50 in 1917, the Foundation has received contributions totaling more than \$1 billion.
